

## TIPS FOR VISITORS

**CALL AHEAD** | A farm is a family business and a home. Respecting the farmer's schedule and privacy is important, so make sure you let them know you're coming.

**PARK IN DESIGNATED AREAS** | If you don't know where to park, just ask.

**COME PREPARED** | Farms are not necessarily accident proof, and they're definitely not weather proof. Come dressed for the weather and wear sturdy, close-toed shoes.

**PICK ONLY WHAT YOU ARE INVITED TO**  
Please remember that the farm's products are its income. Just as you wouldn't eat a box of strawberries as you stroll through the grocery store, it is also not appropriate to snack your way through the farm. Be a good guest, and remind your kids to do the same!

**MIND YOUR FEET** | Stay on the paths. Roots, and the soil itself, need air to stay healthy. It's easy for them to get sick when the soil has been compacted so please don't walk in the plant beds.

**HELP YOUR CHILDREN LEARN TRUE THINGS**  
Your farm visit can be a wonderful opportunity for you to model the learning process with your children. Be curious. Wonder aloud. Ask someone who knows. Listen carefully. Take in this new knowledge. Go home more connected.


